Of Malawi's 20 million people, fewer than 2.5 million have access to grid electricity. 86 Even for those who do, Malawi's electricity system struggles to supply reliable power. This tempts families, industry, small businesses, hospitals, and others to install and use backup diesel generators.

Malawi and GEAPP will begin constructing Africa's first 20 MW battery energy storage system (BESS) in Lilongwe, which is set to be completed in 2025. The \$20 million BESS project will stabilise Malawi's hydropower-reliant grid, enhance electricity access, and reduce carbon emissions by 10,000 tonnes annually.

As of 2022, Malawi's power system has added 80 MW of solar power and decommissioned 78 MW of grid-based diesel generators.
