If the project is built, it could rank among one of the largest single projects in the world, behind Australia's



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Western Green Energy Hub (28GW), a 14GW project in Oman, as well as the 16-20GW Aman project in Mauritania. Chariot Energy has also proposed a 10GW green hydrogen project in Mauritania, which it is working on with French oil giant Total.

In Mauritania, bp will explore the potential for large-scale renewable hydrogen production, and a new report from Masdar has laid out the opportunities on offer for Africa: as much as 10% of the global renewable hydrogen market by 2050, or 60 million tonnes per year.
