



Spark energy hub Equatorial Guinea

Will Equatorial Guinea fulfil its promise as a gas "mega hub," or will stalled negotiations turn what should be a national economic boon into a missed opportunity? The answer depends largely on how quickly the country ...

The Dinawan Energy Hub is a ~2 gigawatt (GW) proposed hybrid wind, solar and storage project located in the Riverina region in New South Wales, in the heart of the South-West Renewable Energy Zone and on the traditional lands of the Wiradjuri people and several smaller nations of the Murrumbidgee plains.

Houston-based energy company Marathon Oil Corporation, through its affiliated company Marathon E.G. Holding Limited, has inked a Heads of Agreement (HOA) with the Republic of Equatorial Guinea (E.G.) and Chevron's Noble Energy E.G. Ltd, to move forward with the next phases in the development of Equatorial Guinea's Gas Mega Hub (GMH).

This agreement, too, aims to supply the GMH and help raise Equatorial Guinea's status as a regional hub for industry infrastructure.
