Why does China have strategic petroleum reserves?

To further ensure a steady and reliable supply of oil, China has built up strategic petroleum reserves (SPR). These reserves are designed to buffer any disruptions in global oil supply chains, such as geopolitical conflicts or supply chain interruptions.

Does China have oil reserves?

Unlike the US, Beijing doesn't publish official inventory data and is especially secretive about its strategic oil reserves. Chinese stockpiles- encompassing onshore commercial holdings and the government's reserves -- have dropped around 9% from a peak in late July, according to the Vortexa figures.

Will China restock its oil reserves in 2024?

Beijing's oil consumption and reserve levels are key to global price trajectories, with moderate restocking expected due to economic struggles. While China's crude imports reached a record high in 2023, its strategic reserve replenishment in 2024 is expected to be cautious and focused on refinery use.

Why is China storing oil in its national reserves?

With oil prices remarkably low in recent years -- the price of a barrel has been below \$80 when it is typically at \$90 to \$100 -- China has decided to store a portion of what it imports in its national reserves. "They're storing up because it's really cheap right now, and they know they need it, and they know that they can use it," Wald said.

Should China's oil reserve be at all time highs?

Realistically, China's reserve should be at or near all time highs to keep in lockstep with growth. Chinese crude stockpiles will likely build this quarter, with "restocking demand from majors," said Jianan Sun, an analyst at Energy Aspects; he predicts that inventories will likely increase by more than 60 million barrels through this year.
